



Since 1987, Heartland Habitat for Humanity has built over 225 homes in Wyandotte, Leavenworth and Johnson Counties in Kansas, and Clay and Platte Counties in Missouri. By working locally with families and volunteers, Heartland Habitat is building homes, strengthening communities and fulfilling dreams.

Heartland Habitat believes that all people deserve a simple and decent place in which to live. Through volunteer labor and tax-deductible donations of money and materials, Heartland Habitat builds and rehabilitates homes with the help of homeowner partner families. Heartland Habitat houses are sold to partner families at no-profit through no-interest loans. The homeowners' monthly mortgage payments are recycled into a revolving Fund for Humanity that is used to build more houses.

Heartland Habitat for Humanity is an affiliate of Habitat for Humanity International, a nonprofit, ecumenical Christian ministry dedicated to eliminating substandard housing and homelessness worldwide.

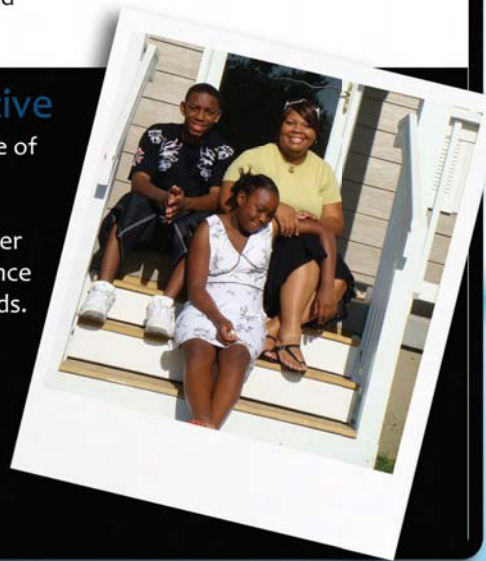


Neighborhood Revitalization Initiative

HOME BUYER

Heartland Habitat for Humanity opens the door to homeownership by providing homes for sale at no profit and no interest to families who qualify. Monthly mortgage payments for Habitat homes range from \$375-\$525, including insurance and taxes. All interested applicants will be required to pay an application fee not to exceed \$25. To qualify for a Heartland Habitat for Humanity home, families must:

- 1. Demonstrate Need** - The family's current living conditions must be inadequate and the family cannot qualify for a conventional loan.
- 2. Ability to Pay** - There must be a steady source of income that falls within the Annual Gross Income Guidelines. Current qualifying income guidelines can be found at www.heartlandhabitat.org/home-owner-info.
- 3. Willingness to Partner** - The family must be willing to partner with Heartland Habitat to complete all program requirements, including 350 hours of "sweat equity" through on-site volunteering and participation in homeowner classes.
